

# REVIEWING THE CONSTITUTION NOV 51.

## MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 2. ANY PERSON 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OVER, WHO HAS HAS BEEN ADMITTED BY A FAVORABLE VOTE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND WHOSE FEES ARE PAID IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE BY-LAWS, IS A MEMBER OF THE CLUB.

BY-LAW 23. AN ENTRANCE FEE OF \$5.00 SHALL BE PAID AT THE TIME OF APPLI-CATION AS SHALL BE PAID THE FIRST YEAR'S DUES, IF APPLICATION IS MADE BEFORE MAY 1ST OR ONE-HALF OF YEAR'S DUES IF APPLICATION IS MADE AFTER MAY 1ST.

BY-LAW 24. THE ANNUAL DUES SHALL BE \$5.00. THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE FROM NOVEMBER 1 TO THE FOLLOWING OCTOBER 31, INCLUSIVE. FROM NOVEMBER 1 TO DECEMBER 31, SHALL BE A PERIOD OF GRACE DURING WHICH TIME FULL MEMBER-SHIP PRIVILEGES WILL BE ALLOWED TO THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S MEMBERS. MEMBERS NOT PAYING THEIR DUES BY JANUARY 1 SHALL AUTOMATICALLY LOSE THEIR MEMBER-SHIP. DUES ARE DUE - SEND YOUR DUES (\$5.00)
