SEPT 14 BOX ELDER PEAK. This peak is the one South (and a little East) of Lone Peak. It is not as high as Lone Peak, and the trail starts quite a ways up American Fork Canyon, so the climb is not so long as up Lone Peak or Twin Peaks. There are several good trails up the mountain; the climb is probably as long as that up Mt. Olympus.
